



Shri Mangu Singh has taken over Managing Director of prestigious Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Ltd on Jan 01, 2012 from Dr E Sreedharan, an iconic personality among Indian engineers who transformed the Delhi's transport sector through metro.

Procurement of works and services for Mega Projects on Design and Built Contracts basis, multilateral funding agencies, development of bid documents for Metro Projects on PPP basis, Management of Concession Contracts. He has also headed the successful Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) Projects of Delhi Metro, the only successful Projects in Railway Transportation Sector in the world.
